


HIGH PRICES, broken promises on prescription drug costs

New survey from the West Health Institute and NORC at the University of Chicago shows few Americans approve of how President Trump and Congress are addressing 'unreasonable' prescription drug costs.

the cost of prescription medication in the United States as unreasonable.




